Support includes:

- Registration of your work in the CEE Library right from the start, promotion and dissemination to a wide audience through the website, mailing list, and writing of policy/practitioner briefs.
- Work on the “Systematic Review Question”, planning financial and human resources, preparing schedules and benchmarks, anticipating the peer-review processes.
- Workshops, training courses and mentoring programmes. These events cover all the different steps of a Systematic Review and can be adjusted to your skills and experience.
- Support for searching strategies and methodologies, statistics, interpretation of results... (face-to-face or by mail or telephone, high flexibility)
- Peer-review process at an early stage (draft protocol) and at the final stage (draft review) to ensure the best possible quality of your SR
- Creation of a special webpage for your Review, and a process of open-consultation to allow for stakeholders feedback.

CEE promotes the use of systematic review methodologies in environmental management and works with many commissioning bodies (FAO, DFID, Defra, Natural England, UNEP...). The CEE Library is now supporting about 50 ongoing SRs.
